



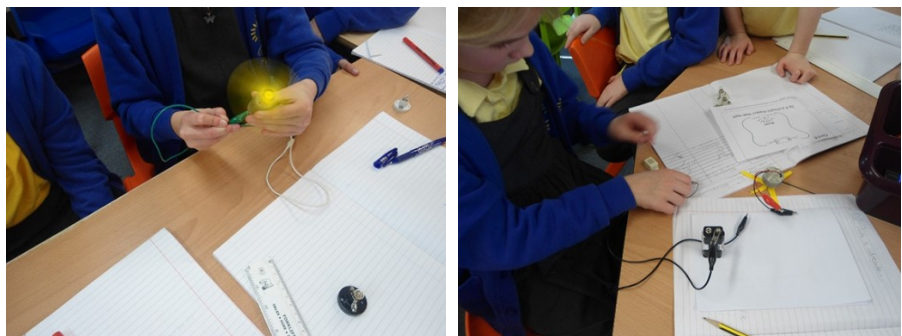

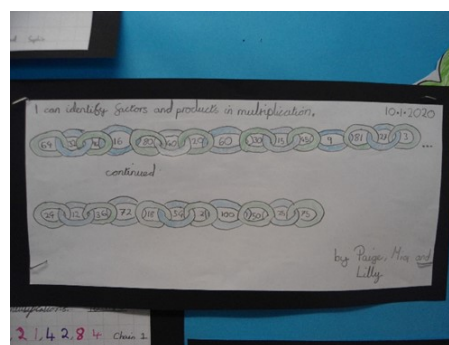

Oak Class have made a good start to the new year and the new topic of the Tudors. They have learnt about the Battle of Bosworth and how the Tudors came to the throne. They enjoyed the story of the battle and we will re-enact it in a short drama session next week. They have learnt how peace was kept by joining the two fighting families together and forming the Tudor Rose. They will be learning about the wives of Henry the VIII, lives of rich and poor, illnesses and cures, crime and punishment, as well as trying out a Tudor recipe and dancing.

In science they have started learning about electricity and had a fun lesson making different circuits to see if they worked. They made predictions and tested each circuit picture.



They have made a lovely maths display in class showing factors and products in multiplication. In English they are writing extended sentences using conjunctions and reading traditional tales from other cultures.
