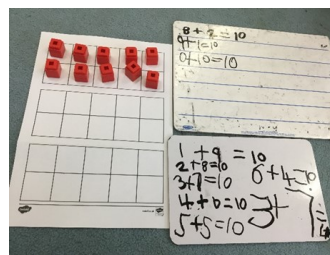
A warm welcome back after February half term. We hope you enjoyed the week off.
