The children were inspired by enclosed spaces and awkward positions in order to perfect their art!

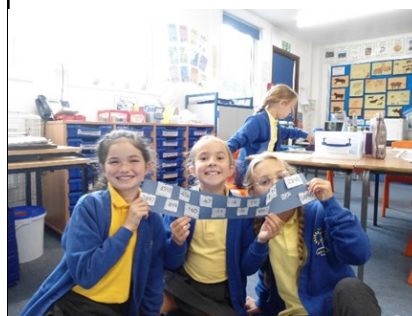
They have learned about life in a Celtic village and tried making pots and doing weaving to experience how things were made.
