Mathematics

For the first half term we will be looking at measurement - length and height, position and direction and time.

After half term the children will also learn about mass, capacity and temperature.

Please continue to help your child practice counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Year 2 practice counting in 3s as well!

ICT

In Computing we are looking at spreadsheets and pictograms.

English

Phonics and spelling is taught each day. Please help your child to learn their weekly spellings.

This term we are looking at stories from other cultures, labels, lists, signs and information texts and poems to say out loud.

Topic and Science

Our topics this term will be Kenya and Changes in Living Memory.

In Art we will be learning about the artist Andy Goldsworthy and creating art out of nature.

After half term we will be tasting different fruits and making a fruit salad.

In Science we will be learning about plants—how they grow and stay healthy.
