This week the children have begun their exploration of our new topic DINOSAURS! We have so much to look forward to, a fossil workshop, making dinosaur eggs, making our very own volcano explosion and so much more! The children have already enjoyed digging for dinosaur bones, playing in the dinosaur park and painting fantastic dinosaur pictures!

Mathematics

This term we will continue to learn about numbers to 10 and beyond, including adding and ordering. We will solve number problems and learn about different types of measurement including weighing, capacity and length.

Literacy

We will be continuing with daily phonics sessions, where we will teach the Phase 3 sounds and practise reading and writing. There will be lots of opportunities for the children to use these skills independently in the classroom.

Topic and Science

This half term we are exploring the topic 'Dinosaurs'. The children will learn about dinosaur names, features, habitats, diet and fossils. In the second half of the spring term our topic is 'Come outside'. We will spend lots of time exploring and watching the natural environment change.
