In Maths, Acorns have been working hard on understanding Odd and Even numbers. They began by using objects

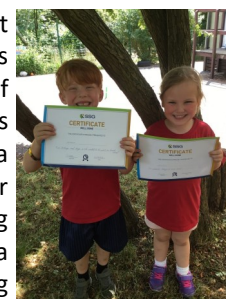
