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This week we celebrate Oak class and their outdoor learning in our local community. A very big thank you to Rosemary Hare and Reverend Nigel Bibbings for letting us visit the Methodist chapel.



As part of our RE topic 'Where, how and why do people worship?' we went to visit the Methodist Chapel.

Gravenhurst. Rosemary showed us around and we learnt lots of interesting facts.

Reverend Nigel then talked to us about his role in the church and explained some of the objects found in the chapel, what they were used for and their importance in the Christian religion.



We looked at lots of old photos and even found some of Gravenhurst Academy celebrating Harvest and Christmas in the past.



In Art we have been continuing to look at prehistoric painting. We went outside and collected natural objects such as berries, leaves, sticks, bark and flowers and used them to make marks on white paper. We discussed which ones worked well and which didn't. We then used sand, couscous and lentils to



recreate the rough surface of a cave wall. We mixed cinnamon, turmeric, paprika and nutmeg with flour and water to make our own paints using natural products.
