In our topic lessons we have explored and learnt about the first birds and how Dinosaurs

shaped the landscape. The children have made their own dinosaur small world landscape in a shoe box. They painted the background and then using craft materials and picture cut outs they created their scene.



We have spent the week recapping the early sounds from phase 3 as we are now embedding the sounds we have learnt. The children are using the sounds in a variety of ways to support them with their ever growing reading and writing skills. It is lovely to see the children using these sounds more independently



and enjoying practising them, in their play.



In Maths we have been focusing on the numbers 6,7 and 8, exploring their composition, making pairs and finding doubles! The
