On Monday Willow class held a 2 minute silence at 11am on the playground with the whole school to show our respect for those that lost their lives during wartime.

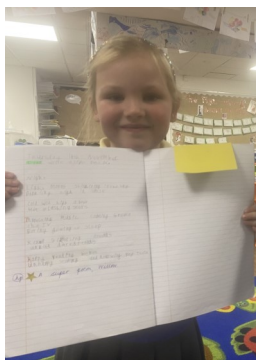


On Tuesday we enjoyed celebrating those that are different by wearing odd socks to school. This way we acknowledged that being different is okay!

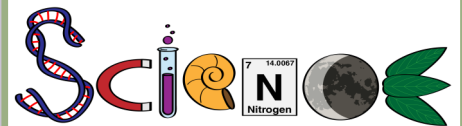
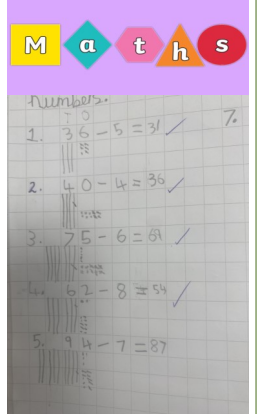


ODD SOCKS DAY
