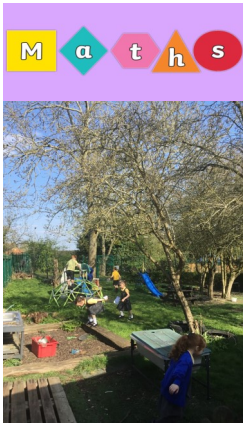

**W**e have had a fantastic week in Acorn Class. We have moved onto Phase 4 phonics, this week we have been focusing on adjacent consonants at the end of words for example, tusk, milk, sand and sink. **Phonics**

The children have worked so hard on trying to identify the harder to hear sounds e.g. sk, lk, nd and nk. They have continued working on sentence writing, making sure they include capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

In Maths we have been doing lots of recapping, involving, odd and even numbers, 2D and 3D shapes and ensuring a concrete understanding of numbers to 10.



In the afternoon we have continued our gymnastics lesson which focused on rolling this week. The children had a go at tuck rolls and sideways rolls. They found this tricky as it uses different muscles, however worked hard to give it a go!



We have talked about plants, including the different features and what they need to grow. We have also watched the process of a caterpillar turning into a butterfly and the children created their own life cycle.
