Welcome to Acorn Class!

This is the first of the three termly newsletters you will receive to keep you informed of what we will be doing over the year.

In Autumn 2 we will be having weekly forest school sessions, the children will spend time exploring the forest, taking part in activities and enjoy being in our beautiful outdoor environment.

Mathematics

We will start the year exploring through play and getting to know each other. After a few weeks we will begin to look at comparing objects and patterns, before moving onto looking into numbers 1, 2 and 3! There is a big focus on the children having a secure understanding of numbers to 10.

Literacy

Our literacy focus will be based on sharing, enjoying and talking about a variety of books and stories. We will spend time exploring the classroom, getting to know each other and playing together. Formal phonics will begin towards the end of this first half term, where we will learn single sounds and the correct letter formation.

Topic

We will explore 2 topics in the Autumn term, these are: 'Ourselves' including People who help us and 'Festivals', We will begin celebrating the children in Acorns and getting to know each other. In Autumn 2 we will explore a variety of festivals, for example, Diwali, Hanukkah, Advent and Christingle.
