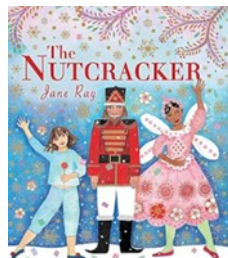
**F**estive greeting from Willow Class!!!! In Willow Class we are now getting well into the festive spirit!
