Acorn class have had a wonderful week. They have continued with phase 4 phonics and are becoming more confident with adjacent consonant and hearing them in words such as skip, swim, sleep and Gran. In Maths we have moved onto our next topic of exploring beyond the number 10.

On Monday the children thoroughly enjoyed Forest School, especially with some signs of sunshine! They explored the forest looking for different minibeasts hiding away, enjoyed swinging in the hammock, making beautiful drawings, building wooden cars, playing with the cuddly woodland animals and trying Jacquie's special homemade Dandelion honey.



We talked about World Earth Day, and explored how important it is to look after our planet and shared ideas on how we can help protect it.

We discussed actions such as litter picking, planting trees and flowers, recycling, and appreciating and taking care of the world around us. We also talked about our favourite places, from the beach to the park and the forest and why they are so special to us. Together, we discussed simple ways we can make a difference every day, like turning off lights to save electricity, using eco-friendly products, and reducing how much water we use. The children then made their own Earth paintings which look fabulous hanging in the classroom.

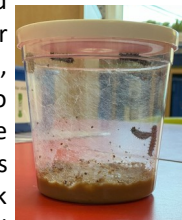


In PE, Kiera worked with the children on their next Tennis session, introducing and refining skills, including control, movement and hand eye coordination.
