Welcome back to school after the half term holidays. Here is what a typical day looks like as a Willow class member.

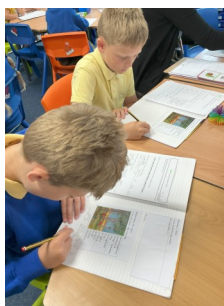
