



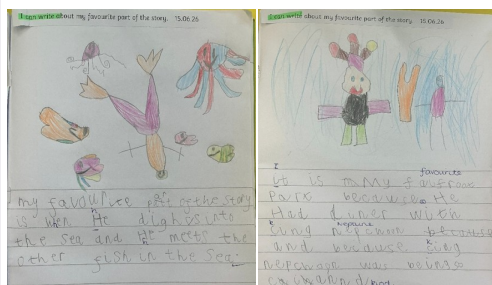
Our Value this month is Honesty

The children then used their phonics and literacy knowledge to draw a picture and write about their favourite part of the story (How amazing is their writing and drawing!).



On Tuesday we recapped the adventure and

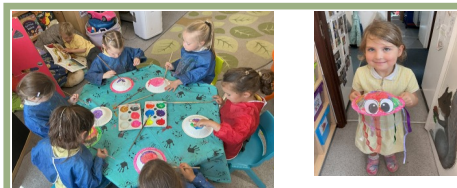


discussed question marks, the children then went on to write a few questions to ask Dougal more about his trip and the great adventure to Atlantis. We then thought about which under the sea animal the

In Maths we have been continuing with 'Mapping' and exploring where things are in relation to each other and giving instructions for how maps can be recreated to ensure they are in the correct place, using terms such as in between, in front of, behind, above and below. Dougal followed a map to Atlantis so we thought we would make our own treasure maps too!



In the afternoon the children have been working hard on making their own brightly coloured Jelly fish! These look fantastic hanging in our classroom. The children really took their time to design their Jelly fish exactly as they wanted and took care with the painting and patterns they wanted to use.
