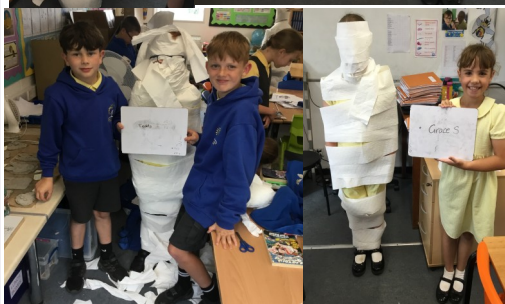
Diary Dates
