Here we are celebrating the 10 years of BEST.

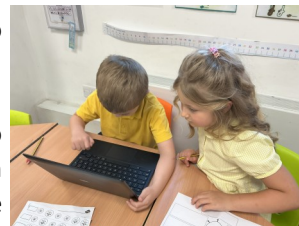


We had lovely ice lollies funded by the Trust!
